### ORDER FOR TRUSTEE RUNOFF ELECTION OF THE EL PASO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, based on the official canvass of the results of the election held on May 6, 2017, it is necessary that a runoff election be held within the El Paso Independent School District for the purpose of electing one (1) Trustee to the Board of Trustees of the El Paso Independent School District, with said runoff election to be held pursuant to Section 11.057(c) and other pertinent provisions of the Texas Education Code and the Texas Election Code:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Trustees of the El Paso Independent School District the following:

- (1) That there be and there is hereby called to be held on June 10, 2017, during the hours prescribed by law (7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.), within the El Paso Independent School District, a runoff election at which there shall be elected one (1) Trustee to the Board of Trustees from the designated district as hereinafter specifically set forth;
- (2) That a Trustee shall be elected, by position, from the following single-member district and the voting shall be accomplished in the respective precincts at the following identified polling places and addresses:

The Position (District) 4 Trustee shall be elected to a four-year term from the following numbered county election precincts, and the voting shall be accomplished at the following identified polling places and addresses:

The El Paso Independent School District Board of Trustees finds that such county election precincts as designated above have previously been served by common polling places by the County of El Paso, and that said common polling places for the said county election precincts can adequately and conveniently serve the affected voters and will facilitate the orderly conduct of this Joint Election with the City of El Paso, pursuant to Tex. Election Code § 271.003.

- That early voting by personal appearance shall take place at the main early voting polling place, Third Floor, El Paso County Courthouse, 500 East San Antonio during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; and also at such other branch early voting polling places as may be maintained by the County Elections Administrator in this Joint Election. Early voting by personal appearance shall take place on the dates and during the hours required by law, and at such additional dates and hours as may be maintained by the County Elections Administrator, during the period commencing May 30 and ending June 6, 2017, as reflected by Exhibit "A" attached hereto. The Board authorizes the Superintendent to make such changes to the polling places, dates and hours for early voting as may be recommended by the County Elections Administrator and authorized by law.
- (4) That early voting ballots may be voted by mail, pursuant to Chapter 86 of the Texas Election Code. Applications for an early voting ballot may be submitted by U.S. mail addressed to the Early Voting Clerk, Lisa Wise, at the Office of the County Elections Administrator, 500 E. San Antonio, Suite 314, El Paso, Texas 79901, or may be submitted by email to ballotrequests@epcounty.com. The deadline for receipt by the County Elections Administrator of an application for an early

voting ballot to be voted by mail shall be May 30, 2017, as determined by Section 84.007 of the Texas Election Code. Late ballot voting shall be conducted pursuant to Chapters 102 and 103 of the Texas Election Code.

- That the Superintendent of the El Paso Independent School District, and designees, are hereby appointed to hold such runoff election, to provide all necessary facilities for the holding and conduct thereof, and generally to care for and arrange all details of said runoff election, including the selection, replacement and/or substitution of election personnel, to the extent not specifically appointed herein, and subject to the Contract for Election Services to be entered into with the El Paso County Elections Department. Qualified judges and clerks will be used in the runoff election. No employees of the El Paso Independent School District will serve as an election official. A Central Counting Station shall be used for the runoff election. Precinct judges, and certain other election personnel, are appointed as stated on Exhibit "B" attached hereto, and as stated in the Contract to be entered into with the El Paso County Elections Department. The persons authorized to provide for and conduct said elections shall make all necessary instructions therefor.
- (6) That the candidates in said runoff election shall be Diane M. Dye and Russell Wiggs in District 4. Each candidate must be a resident of the single-member district within the El Paso Independent School District which the candidate seeks to represent and must be a qualified voter and otherwise qualified to hold the position of Trustee of a public Independent School District under Texas law.
- (7) That ballots conforming to the requirements of the law of the State of Texas shall be prepared with the names, without titles, of all candidates, and that said ballots shall be provided by the persons above appointed to hold said election and shall be distributed in due time to the judges holding said elections, together with the necessary voter registration lists showing voters qualified to vote within the applicable voting precincts of the El Paso Independent School District. All such resident, qualified voters of the District shall be entitled to vote in the runoff election. The electronic or touch-screen voting system used by the County of El Paso is hereby adopted by the District for use in the runoff election.
- (8) That the two candidates participating in said runoff election will meet in the Board Room of the EPISD Education Center Boeing Building, 6531 Boeing Drive, El Paso, Texas, on Thursday, the 18th day of May, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. (or as soon thereafter as they may meet, at the call of the Superintendent or designee), for the ballot order drawing in accordance with law, and, by a drawing pursuant to Texas Election Code § 52.094, determine the order in which their respective names shall appear on said ballot. Notice of the drawing shall be posted and mailed in accordance with Texas Election Code § 52.094 (c) and (d).
- (9) That this runoff election shall be combined with other elections to be held on the same date. That the President of this Board of Trustees has been authorized to and has executed an Interlocal Agreement for a Joint Election, including any necessary runoff elections, with the City of El Paso pursuant to, and meeting the requirements of, Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code, and Section 11.0581 of the Education Code. That the President of this Board of Trustees be and is hereby authorized to execute a Contract for Election Services with the El Paso County Elections Administrator regarding the operation and cost of this Board of Trustees runoff election.
- (10) That notice of the runoff election and copy of this Order shall be posted on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the Board of Trustees, and on the District's Internet website, not later than May 22, 2017, and shall remain posted continuously through election day, pursuant to Tex. Election Code § 4.003. Notice of the runoff election, including the location of each polling place and the hours the polls will be open, shall also be published, not earlier than May 11, 2017, and not later than May 31, 2017, in a newspaper published within the EL PASO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, pursuant to Tex. Election Code § 4.003. Notice of the runoff election shall be delivered to the County Clerk of El Paso County not later than May 17, 2017, pursuant to Tex. Election Code § 4.008.

- That said runoff election shall be held and returns thereof made to the Board of Trustees of the El Paso Independent School District in accordance with the general election laws, and that said Board of Trustees shall canvass such returns, declare the results of such runoff election, and issue a certificate of election to the person shown by such returns to have been elected.
- (12) The candidate receiving the majority of votes shall be elected to the corresponding Trustee position. A tie vote shall be resolved pursuant to Texas Election Code § 2.028.
