TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

CNA (LOCAL)

ELIGIBILITY

The District shall not provide transportation to any student for whom it does not receive state transportation funds, except as required by law and as provided in this policy.

THE DISTRICT SHALL PERMIT STUDENTS FOR WHOM THE DISTRICT DOES NOT RECEIVE STATE TRANSPORTATION FUNDS TO USE DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH TIME AND SPACE LIMITATIONS AND ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS.

APPLICABLE FEES, IF ANY, SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS.

HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS

No later than May 15 each year, the Board shall adopt a resolution to identify hazardous conditions within two miles of a school campus for the following school year. The resolution shall describe the specific hazardous areas where students reside who would otherwise be ineligible for transportation, but for whom the District shall provide transportation because of the hazardous conditions in those areas.

The District shall publish the locations of the routes with hazardous conditions.

MAGNET SCHOOL OR SPECIAL PROGRAM

A student enrolled in a Board-approved magnet program or special program within the District shall be provided transportation to the respective magnet school or special program if the student lives two or more miles from the magnet school that he or she will be attending or if the student lives in a designated hazardous area.
