## STUDENT CONDUCT PROHIBITED ORGANIZATIONS AND HAZING

PROHIBITED	The Board prohibits the existence of gangs, gangs-related behav-
ACTIVITIES	ior, the wearing of gang-related apparel, and gang activities within
	the jurisdiction of the District because the presence of such gangs
	and gang activities can cause substantial disruption of the instruc-
	tional program. For purposes of this policy, a "gang" is defined to
	include a group of two or more persons whose purposes include
	the commission of disruptive and/or illegal acts. Prohibited gang-
	related activities shall be listed in the Student Code of Conduct.
	Hazing shall be prohibited within the jurisdiction of the District. The consequences for gang-related behaviors and hazing shall be ad- dressed in the Student Code of Conduct.
	The campus principal or designee shall document and update as needed known or suspected gang-related apparel, gang hand sig- nals, gang signatures, mottoes, or graffiti and shall notify students and parents accordingly. The student handbook shall serve to pro- vide notice to parents and students in this regard.
INITIATION RITES	Students shall have prior approval from the principal or designee for any type of "initiation rites" of a school club or organization.
REPORTS	Any teacher, administrator, or other person employed by the Dis- trict, or any student who observes any other student engaged in any form of hazing, or who has reason to know or suspect that a student or students intend(s) to engage in hazing, shall report that fact or suspicion to the campus principal or designee.
