

PROPOSED REVISIONS

UIL PARTICIPATION	A student desiring to participate in the UIL athletic program shall submit annually a statement from a health care provider authorized under UIL rules indicating that the student has been examined and is physically able to participate in the athletic program. This examination is required annually, dated on or after the last Friday in May of the current year.
JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC)	For each student enrolling in JROTC, the student's parents or guardians shall complete a medical statement attesting to the physical condition of their sons, daughters, or wards student .
ALL GRADES	Medical examinations may be requested by the principal, based on a recommendation by the school nurse, for any student who has had excessive absences for health reasons, or excessive excuses from physical education classes, as well as for students whose emergency information record card [see FFAC(LOCAL)] or health history indicates a need for medical assessment. All students without a regular health care provider may be referred to the Wainwright Family Resource Center, the school-based health center located on the Wainwright Elementary campus. [See FFAE]
ADDITIONAL SCREENING	The District may provide additional screening as District and community resources permit.
REFERRALS	Parents of students identified through any screening programs as needing treatment or further examination shall be advised of the need and referred to appropriate health agencies.
