SCHOOL SOCIAL FUNCTIONS

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLSCLASS PARTIES AND PICNICS The following guidelines will apply:

PTA room representatives may sponsor no more than two room parties during the school year, one of which will be the prior-to-the-winter-holiday party. An expenditure for both parties, not to exceed \$2 per student, may be collected from the parents on a voluntary basis by the PTA. Permission for all other treats must be obtained from the principal. All parties given on school time must be held on school property.ALL SCHOOL-RELATED SOCIAL ACTIVITIES MUST BE PLANNED BY THE TEACHERS AND STU-DENTS WHEN APPROPRIATE. PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE PRINCIPAL IS REQUIRED.

CLASS PARTIES AND PICNICS INVOLVING HOME-ROOM PARENTS WILL BE LIMITED TO 2 EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

CONTRIBUTIONS BY PARENTS FOR PARTY RE-FRESHMENTS AND DECORATIONS WILL BE VOLUN-TARY. IF MONEY IS COLLECTED, THERE WILL BE A \$3.00 LIMIT PER STUDENT PER EVENT. STUDENTS CANNOT BE PROHIBITED FROM PARTICIPATING IF PARENT DOES NOT PAY.

PRIVATE BIRTHDAY PARTIES WILL NOT BE HELD AT SCHOOL DURING REGULAR SCHOOL HOURS. INVITA-TIONS WILL NOT BE DISTRIBUTED AT SCHOOL UN-LESS THE ENTIRE CLASS GROUP IS INVITED. [SEE FNAA]

Parties will be scheduled during the last portion of the school day and will not exceed one and one-half hours in duration.

MIDDLE SCHOOLS 2. Parties or dances at middle schools will be scheduled at the end of the school day and will not exceed two hours in duration. Grade 8 end-of-the-year parties or dances may be held off campus with the approval of the appropriate assistant/associate superintendent for schools.
