

## PROPOSED REVISIONS

### **Hazardous Traffic Conditions and High- Risk Areas**

If the District applies for the additional transportation allotment provided by the state for students who live within two miles of a school campus, the Board shall adopt a resolution to identify hazardous traffic conditions or areas presenting a high risk of violence within two miles of the school campus. The resolution shall include the specific hazardous or high-risk areas in which transportation shall be provided, and the District shall publish the locations of these routes. ~~No later than May 15 of each year, the Board shall adopt a revised resolution when necessary to accurately reflect changes to the conditions or areas or to confirm the current conditions or areas.~~

### **Magnet School or Special Program**

A student enrolled in a Board-approved magnet program or special program within the District shall be provided transportation to the respective magnet school or special program if the student lives two or more miles from the magnet school that he or she will be attending or if the student lives in a designated hazardous area.
