ADMISSIONS INTRADISTRICT TRANSFERS AND CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS

FDB (LOCAL)

PROPOSED REVISIONS

A student shall be assigned to a school in the attendance area in which he or she resides.

Class Changes

The campus principal shall be authorized to investigate and approve the transfer of a student from one classroom to another on that campus.

Transfers Between Schools

The Superintendent or designee shall be authorized to investigate and approve transfers between schools.

Factors

In approving transfers, the Superintendent or designee shall consider the availability of space and instructional staff.

Transfer Conditions and Expectations

If the initial transfer request is denied, the parents may appeal the decision in accordance with the procedures outlined in the petitions and objections section of FDB(REGULATION).

Once a resident student transfer is approved to **ATTEND** a school, and as long as IF the student is continuously enrolled at that District school and abides by the transfer agreement, the student shall be allowed to complete his or her academic program at that District school, unless the transfer is revoked.

All transfer students must follow all rules and regulations of the District and the transfer agreement.

When considering a transfer revocation, the campus principal shall only review the student's disciplinary history and attendance records.

If the transfer is revoked, the parent shall be notified in writing. The parent may appeal the decision in accordance with the procedures as outlined in the revocation section of FDB(REGULATION). If the final appeal is denied, the student shall be required to enroll at his or her attendance area school.

UIL Varsity Participation

A STUDENT'S ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN UIL COMPETITION SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE *UIL CONSTITUTION AND CONTEST RULES*.

Students on approved transfer shall be ineligible for UIL varsity competition (including athletic) for one year from the date of enrollment except students who transfer due to acceptance in an academic or magnet program.

Note:

For the transfer of a student who is the victim of bullying or who engaged in bullying, see FDB(LEGAL). For the transfer of a student who attends a persistently

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dangerous school, becomes a victim of a violent criminal offense, or becomes a victim of sexual assault, see FDE.
