**Letter Grades and  
Numerical  
Equivalents**

For students arriving to the District from a district that has letter grades with no numerical equivalent, the following must be completed:

- Contact the sending district/campus to verify whether there are numerical equivalents for the letter grades given
- Notate the response from the campus and place supporting documentation with the student's file
- When no numerical equivalents exist, the receiving campus shall use the following to determine the numerical equivalent for each grade:

<u>Letter Grade</u>	<u>Numerical Grade Equivalent</u>
A+	<del>99</del> <b>100</b>
A	<del>95</del> <b>96</b>
A-	<del>91</del> <b>92</b>
B+	89
B	<del>85</del> <b>86</b>
B-	<del>81</del> <b>82</b>
C+	79
C	<del>75</del> <b>76</b>
C-	<del>71</del> <b>72</b>

Additionally, when a student earns a letter grade of a "D" outside of the District to include El Paso Community College (EPCC) and a "D" is a passing grade, the student will be assigned the numerical equivalent of 70.
