Certificate of Coursework Completion

The District shall issue a certificate of coursework completion to a student who has successfully completed state and local credit requirements for graduation but has failed to meet all applicable state testing requirements. [See EIF, FMH]

Partial Credit

When a student earns a passing grade in only half of a course and the ~~combined grade for~~ **AVERAGE OF** both halves is lower than 70, the District shall award the student credit for the half with the passing grade.

Full Credit Course Grade Averaging

When awarding credits for year-long courses (for example: English 1A/English 1B) taken within the same academic school year, credit shall be awarded for both parts of the course if a student scores at least a 60 in either the first semester or the second semester of the course, and the average of the grades for the first semester and the second semester is 70 or higher. All such averaging must occur by the end of June of the school year in which the course was taken. Exceptions shall be made by the principal under extenuating circumstances.

Grades shall be posted to reflect the academic year (August–July) in which credit was earned.

Parts of courses not taken during the same academic school year or taken outside the District shall not be subject to this averaging procedure.

[Parts of year-long courses from outside the District may be posted with documentation from the sending school district and in accordance with District regulation.]
