NECTING LANGUAGES/DUAL LANGUAGE, WHETHER DI-RECTLY INVOLVED WITH DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION OR NOT DIRECTLY INVOLVED WITH DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCA-TION, SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN SIX HOURS OF DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION PROFESSIONAL DEVEL-OPMENT.

PEIMS PEIMS SHALL ADDRESS ALL CODING AND PROCEDURES TO FACILITATE THE IDENTIFICATION, DATA, COLLECTION AND REPORTING, FOR MONITORING AND EVALUATING DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION IN THE DISTRICT.
