	WITH AT LEAST ONE EMPLOYEE MANAGING EACH PRO- JECT, STUDENTSSCHOOL SPONSOREDFund-raising activities by student groups and/or for school-sponsored projects shall be al- lowed, with prior administration approval and under the supervision of the project sponsor, for students in all grades.
	All fund-raising projects shall comply with the guidelines in the Campus Accounting Manual and shall be subject to the approval of the principal. Fund raising activities involving cash collection jars or raffles shall not be permitted.
	Student participation in approved fund-raising activities shall not in- terfere with the regular instructional program. [See EC] Funds raised shall be received, deposited, and disbursed in accordance with CFD(LOCAL).
EOR OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS	Students representing their school OR THE DISTRICT may participate in APPROVED FUNDRAISING TO charitable institution and community drives. Such participation, which shall be on a strictly voluntary basis and shall not disrupt the regular school day, shall be open to students in all grades. School-approved clubs shall be permitted to hold their own fund raising projects for the benefit THE DISTRICT OR A of nonschool charitable ORGANIZATION. PAR-TICIPATIONorganizations or nonprofit entities [see policy CFD]. Students shall also be VOLUNTARY AND SHALL BE APPROVED ONLY WHEN THE FUNDRAISING ACTIVITY RELATES permitted to THE DISTRICT'S EDUCATIONAL MISSION.conduct non-monotary drives (i.e., canned food or toys).
	FUNDRAISING SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED DURING CLASS TIME. [SEE EC]
	No outside organizations of any sort may solicit contributions of any type from students within the schools.
LOSS OF CLASS TIME	The collection of monies that takes the time of the students or teachers during school hours is strictly forbidden, unless the mon- ies collected represent payment for school lunches, monies that will benefit the school or its students, or other authorized fees. [See also FP]
	The Board shall regularly be informed of approved fund raising projects and shall periodically review the effect of such activity on the student body, the instructional program, and the community.
