IF THE DISTRICT APPLIES FOR THE ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION ALLOTMENT PROVIDED BY THE STATE FOR STUDENTS WHO LIVE ~~No later than May 15 each year, the Board shall adopt a resolution to identify hazardous conditions within two miles of a school campus, for the~~ **BOARD SHALL ADOPT A RESOLUTION TO IDENTIFY HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS OR AREAS PRESENTING A HIGH RISK OF VIOLENCE WITHIN TWO MILES OF THE** ~~following school~~ **CAMPUS** ~~year. MAGNET SCHOOL OR
SPECIAL PROGRAM

A student enrolled in a Board-approved magnet program or special program within the District shall be provided transportation to the respective magnet school or special program if the student lives two or more miles from the magnet school that he or she will be attending or if the student lives in a designated hazardous area.
