TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT STUDENT TRANSPORTATION CNA (LOCAL)

ELIGIBILITY The District shall permit students for whom the District does not receive state transportation funds to use District transportation, in accordance with time and space limitations and administrative regulations. Applicable fees, if any, shall be approved by the Beard and published in administrative regulations. IF THE DISTRICT APPLIES FOR THE ADDITIONAL TRANS-HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS AND PORTATION ALLOTMENT PROVIDED BY THE STATE FOR **HIGH RISK AREAS** STUDENTS WHO LIVE No later than May 15 each year, the Board shall adopt a resolution to identify hazardous conditions within two miles of a school campus, for the BOARD SHALL ADOPT A RES-**OLUTION TO IDENTIFY HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS OR AREAS PRESENTING A HIGH RISK OF VIOLENCE WITHIN** TWO MILES OF THEfollowing school CAMPUSyear. The resolution shall INCLUDEdescribe the specific hazardous OR HIGH RISK areas where students reside who would otherwise be ineligible for transportation, but for whom the District shall provide transportation because of the hazardous conditions in these areas IN WHICH TRANSPORATION SHALL BE PROVIDED, AND THE The District shall publish the locations of THESE the routes. NO LATER THAN MAY 15 OF EACH YEAR, THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT A REVISED RESOLUTION WHEN NECESSARY TO AC-CURATELY REFLECT CHANGES TO THE CONDITIONS OR AR-EAS OR TO CONFIRM THE CURRENT with hazardous conditions OR AREAS. MAGNET SCHOOL OR A student enrolled in a Board-approved magnet program or special SPECIAL PROGRAM program within the District shall be provided transportation to the respective magnet school or special program if the student lives two or more miles from the magnet school that he or she will be at-
