General Education	Consistent with TEA's <i>Student Attendance Accounting Handbook</i> (<i>SAAH</i>), a student MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR GENERAL EDUCA-TION HOMEBOUND SERVICES IF THE STUDENT IS to be con- fined for a minimum of four weeks to a hospital or homebound SETTING for medical reasons specifically documented by a physi- cian licensed to practice in the United States may be eligible for general education homebound services. The WEEKS OF CON- FINEMENT NEED NOT BE CONSECUTIVE. THE PARENT'S re- quest for services shall be made through SUBMITTED TO the prin- cipal in accordance with TEA's <i>SAAH</i> and administrative procedures.
	The principal or designee shall convene a placement committee composed of at least a campus administrator, a teacher of the stu- dent, and the parent or guardian of the student to consider the ne- cessity of providing general education homebound instruction to the student. If the committee determines that such instruction is ap- propriate, the committee shall determine the type and amount of in- struction to be provided and, when the student is able to return to the regular educational settingIF APPLICABLE, the length of the transition period TO THE SCHOOL-BASED SETTING based on current medical information.
Special Education	For students who receive CONSISTENT WITH STATE RULE AND THE SAAH, A STUDENT RECEIVING special education services; the MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION HOME- BOUND SERVICES IF THE STUDENT IS TO BE CONFINED FOR A MINIMUM OF FOUR WEEKS TO A HOSPITAL OR HOME- BOUND SETTING FOR MEDICAL REASONS SPECIFICALLY DOCUMENTED BY A PHYSICIAN LICENSED TO PRACTICE IN THE UNITED STATES. IF A STUDENT IS CHRONICALLY ILL, THE STUDENT'S ADMISSION, REVIEW, AND DISMISSAL (ARD) COMMITTEE SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER THE WEEKS OF CONFINEMENT NEED TO BE CONSECUTIVE.
	IF THE ARD COMMITTEE DETERMINES THAT HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION IS APPROPRIATE, THE committee shall deter- mine the type and amount of instruction to be provided and, when the student is able to return to the regular educational settingIN
